



Kinship Care

Provides case management to Aboriginal children and their carers when the child is placed in the care of a family member. Some ACCOs include support to Aboriginal carers who have 'informal' care arrangements

First Supports

Provides supports to new kinship care placements to build Carer capacity. Can include

- Family service hours to support the family.
- Brokerage

Kinship Carer Recruitment

Helps kinship carers through the recruitment process and provide ongoing support. It includes

- Delivering training
- Implementing the carer recruitment & marketing strategy
- Arranging care gatherings, cultural awareness activities and support groups

Kinship Care After Hours

An after hours phone number for kinship carers to call if they need assistance.

Kinship Re-unification

Intensive family services for the reunification of Aboriginal children and young people. This program is part of a state-wide kinship finding service.

Therapeutic Home-Based Care

Support carers and care teams to deliver trauma informed and therapeutic responses to children and young people in out of home care. The aim is to enhance the therapeutic care for Aboriginal children and young people in foster and kinship care

Foster Care

Providing support and case management to Aboriginal children and their carers when the child is in out-of-home care

Foster Care Recruitment

Assist carers through the recruitment processes and provide them with ongoing support. It includes delivering training, implementing the carer recruitment, and marketing strategy and arranging carer gatherings and support groups

Cultural Leadership Program

A hybrid foster care program designed to support children and young people in foster care to remain connected to their culture and Community
